2020 Anticoagulation Boot Camp



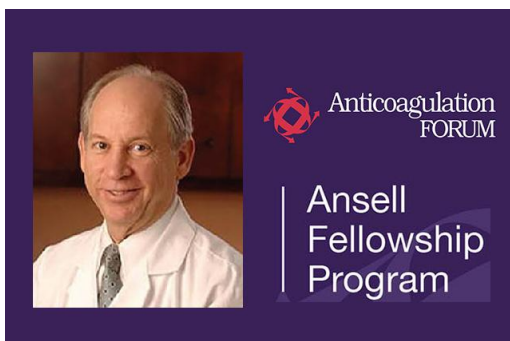

THSNA 2020: 5th Biennial Summit

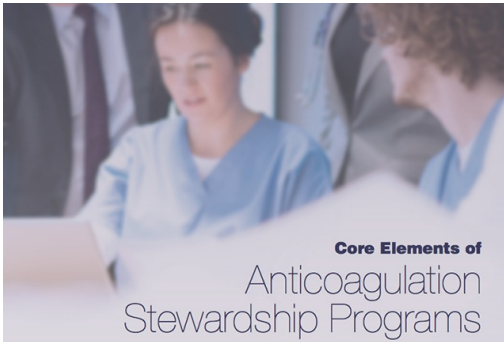
