Pharmacy and Medically Underserved Areas Enhancement Act

In an additional effort to support the *Pharmacy and Medically Underserved Areas Enhancement Act (H.R. 2759); S. 1362*, Anticoagulation Forum has submitted letters of support for the proposed legislation to the individual bill sponsors in both the US Senate and House of Representatives. The letters carry the names, professions, and titles of members of ACF's multidisciplinary Board of Directors and Advisory Council and articulate our collective desire for patients to have access to high quality anticoagulation management services, regardless of where they live or which qualified professionals provide these necessary services.

If you have interest in supporting the legislation yourself, the American Pharmacists Association has created a pre-written, editable advocacy alert that you may use to ask your U.S. Representative and Senators to co-sponsor the bill (H.R. 2759/S. 1362) or thank them if they have already signed on to the legislation. The form will automatically populate with the correct “please support” or “thank you” text based on your address.
